botanist, zoologist, anatomist, physiologist; investigated anatomy of nerves, carried out study of plant growth and early champion of the view that the cell is the basic structural unit of plants; studied parasitic worms and first to detail their life cycle; stressed the importance of chemistry and the role of the exact sciences in medicine and biology.
