studied chemistry of the methylpentoses and introduced *d,l* nomenclature to sugar and carbohydrate chemistry; discovered Votoček's reagent for the determination of sulfite and introduced sodium nitroprusside for mercurimetric titrations; isolated, analyzed, and synthesized saccharides, saccharide acids, and alcohols; composed over 70 works for piano and various ensembles and wrote a seven-language chemical dictionary.
